6" x 6" piece of 18 count mono canvas in a color of your choice.






1 Using Caron Collection Impressions 7041 (●), stitch the first 2 x 2 eyelet in the center of the canvas. Stitch additional eyelets around that center and stitch groups of tent stitches to form a grid of boxes.


- 2 Using Caron Collection Impressions 6002 (), stitch sets of tent stitches inside the open boxes.
- **3** Using Kreinik #16 006DMC 5 (\bigcirc), stitch 2 x 2 diagonals to cover the open canvas threads and form a diamond pattern.

Actual size: 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"










Each petal is stitched on one corner of the center. Rotate your canvas and follow the chart. The upper left corner is shown below.

- **4** Using Caron Collection Impressions 1092 (\bigcirc), stitch partial Scotch stitches from center to point.
- **5** Using Caron Collection Impressions 2035 () tent stitch in diagonal lines to fill out the Scotch stitches.
- 6 Using Rainbow Gallery Panache PN09 (●), complete the Scotch stitches.



Fill the spaces between the petals with tent and reverse tent stitches forming a square or let the color of the canvas be the background.
